The EA has been completed and will be presented at the public hearing. The EA describes the purpose and need of the proposed project, alternatives considered, the recommended preferred alternative, anticipated environmental impacts, project benefits and potential mitigation measures. It will be available for public review and comment on the project website at IL47WoodstockStudy.com, Woodstock Public Library, Woodstock City Hall and the Department's District One office in Schaumburg. Comments will be accepted through June 21, 2018.
